



Boo's 360-ROD Static Detector

Intro

The 360 is an established 360 Static Detector that employs four AA batteries. It encompasses sixteen acrylic ROD LEDs that are regulated by two distinct circuits, housing eight LEDs per circuit. Each circuit comprises of four colors - two Red, two Yellow, two Green, and two Blue. Upon detecting a static, the 360 will illuminate LEDs as per the static it has detected. This advanced functionality theoretical enables the user to request the spirits to activate a specific side, a particular color or allow the 360 to interact with them.

Setup and Use

The 360 Static Detector requires four AA batteries that are to be inserted at the bottom. We recommend using Alkaline batteries or Lithium for extended use, although any type of AA batteries can also be used. The 360 comes equipped with two antennas. While the 360 can be used with or without the antennas, we recommend testing with and without to ensure your preferred performance. Installing the antennas is easy - simply screw them onto the antenna studs and hand-tighten without excessive force. The power switch is located at the center of the top, and when turned on, a small RGB LED lights up above the switch. After turning on the 360, it may accumulate a charge from the static on your body. Please allow 30-60 seconds for the detector to discharge on its own. If it fails to discharge, try touching the antennas to release the static charge. The 360 is ready to use when all 16 LEDs turn off
